THOUGHT

Abraham played a significant role in the birthing of Christianity, Judaism, and Islam—religions that claim 54% of the world's population. Christians and Jews consider Abraham the father of their respective faiths. His name was mentioned 312 times in the bible. In this series we will discuss why it is that Abraham had such a significant role in world religions. We'll discover what makes his story so significant that we still talk about it and learn from it today. In this discussion we will look at Abraham's calling, covenant, and commitment. At the age of 75, God commanded Abraham to GO and settle in a new land. He promised to give him a great name and make him distinguished in a new nation where he will be a blessing to others. God promises that Abraham will gain a new legacy that will continue for generations.

1. CALLING
